

Maths and Numeracy

- **Data handling** - Research and collect data about the different languages spoken in Wales, Cardiff or even your own class. Create a bar chart or pie chart - you can draw this on paper or use Google Forms!
- **Money/currency** - Compare coins/currency from around the world.
- **Cooking/measure** - Measure out ingredients to make a traditional Welsh recipe *and/or* a recipe from another culture. **Challenge:** Can you give a Welsh recipe a twist?

Over the next few weeks, we would like you to try to choose/complete at **least 1 task from each Area of Learning** in the Homework Menu.

- **Family trees** - With help from a friend or family member, create a family tree - can you find out if your family has any roots that go beyond Wales?
- **Your local area** - Visit some of Cardiff's scenic spots with your family and take photographs – send them on Class Dojo or create a presentation to show in class!

- **Designing** - Design a Welsh Dragon or Chinese dragon.
