### Literacy

This term we will be focusing on developing our basic skills in reading and writing. We will be reading and interpreting a variety of texts, and producing extended writing as part of our lessons, in a range of genres. Our first topic will be called 'This is Me' where we will be learning about how we are all different and unique and what makes us all so wonderfully individual.

We have high expectations for handwriting and presentation, and we will be developing these throughout the term. We will be working on our speaking and listening skills through a range of oracy activities.

### Numeracy

There will be a big focus on developing our core number and place value skills during Autumn Term. We will be continuing with our daily CLIC sessions, as well as following White Rose Maths during our main Maths lessons to ensure that children are accessing fluency, reasoning and problem solving activities in all lessons.

Maths homework will be provided online, either through Active Learn or Google Classroom. Please help to support your child's progress by practicing times-tables and basic number skills at home.

We will also be continuing to use Times Table Rock Stars throughout the year, so please spend some time at home playing! Remember, the more you play the more TTRS coins to get!

'Real PE' sessions will take place every **Monday afternoon.**
