- Creating Diva Lamps to take home



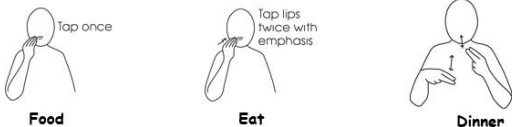
Home Learning
