

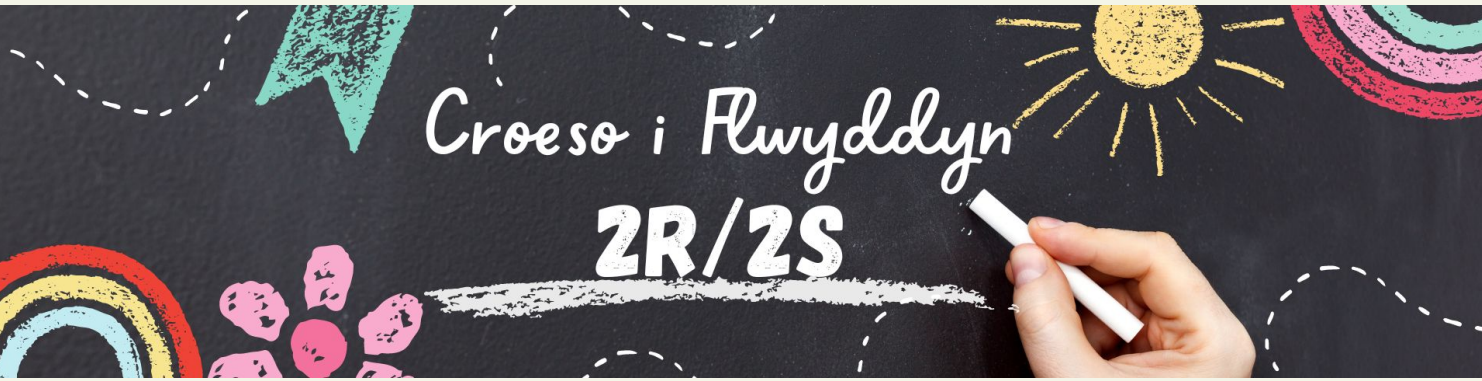

## LITERACY, LANGUAGE & COMMUNICATION

As our theme has a 'Health and Well-Being' focus. We will be learning to write a set of instructions on how to make a healthy fruit salad or plate of food.

## MIND, BODY AND SOUL

The first half of the Autumn term our topic is 'Healthy Living'. We will be covering the importance of exercise, hygiene, internet safety and they will learn about the difference food groups. .

The lessons planned will be based around pupil voice and what the class would like to learn about in relation to the topic.

## MATHS & NUMERACY

There will be a big focus on developing our confidence in place value, addition, subtraction and shape including 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.

## SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

This half term we will continue to develop our knowledge and understanding of how to safely use ICT equipment in school and will also cover a range of skills including how to click and drag, alignment, format images and moving text boxes.

We will also focus on pupils understanding and identifying what is in their digital footprint.

## HEALTH AND WELL-BEING

We will be developing our knowledge and understanding of emotions through stories and rhymes and we will complete a daily emotion check in. During our PE session we will first focus on completing a variety of static balance poses.

## EXPRESSIVE ARTS

## LITERACY, LANGUAGE & COMMUNICATION

We will be covering a range of skills in LLC this half term, including using adjectives to describe The Great Fire of London, writing diary entries and writing a biography about Samuel Pepys. In Welsh we will be learning to answer the question 'Ble rwyd ti'n byw?' and discussing where we live.

## WE ARE TIME TRAVELLERS

Following pupil voice discussions, Year 2 have decided to travel back in time to The Great Fire of London.

They will dive into this topic by comparing London in the past and present, and will learn about Samuel Pepys and his significance in The Great Fire of London.

## MATHS & NUMERACY

This half term we will be developing our knowledge and understanding of addition, subtraction and shape, where we will be looking at both 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.

Please continue to help to support your child's progress by practicing their basic number skills in 'Numbots'. We will then begin to use 'TTRockstars' in school to support the development and knowledge of their times-tables.



## SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

This half term we will continue to develop our knowledge and understanding of how to safely use ICT equipment in school and will also cover a range of skills.

The children will also begin to learn basic coding skills using J2E.

Linking to our topic, the children will also be learning about how The Great Fire of London started, looking at the properties of fire.

## HEALTH AND WELL-BEING

During our PE sessions this half term, we will be taking our previous learning of balancing skills and applying them in different movement-based activities.

The Year 2 pupils will also be spending time learning about their Child's Rights and discussing which ones are most important to them.

## EXPRESSIVE ARTS

During this half term, the Year 2 pupils will be releasing their inner artists by creating oil pastel pictures of The Great Fire of London. They will be learning new techniques and be inspired by the work of Jan Griffier.
