### Big Maths

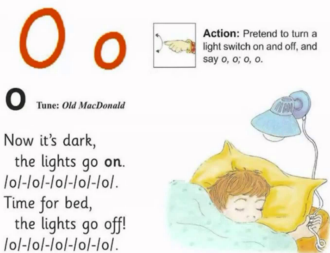
This week, we will be practicing **writing our number 2** and learning how to form it carefully. We will use our **pencils, fingers, and fun activities** to help us practice!
