This week, some of the fun things we'll be doing are:

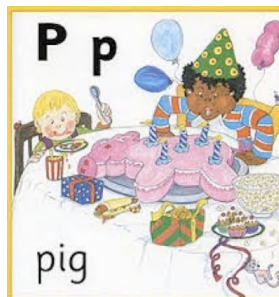
- Celebrating the festival of Diwali
