We will be:

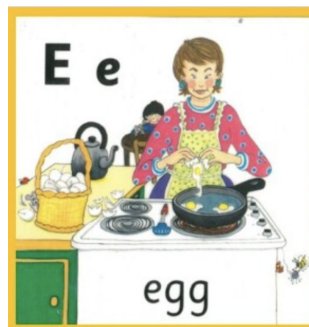
- Sharing the story *Real Superheroes* by Julia Seal
