- Comparing and ordering leeks and daffodils by size.

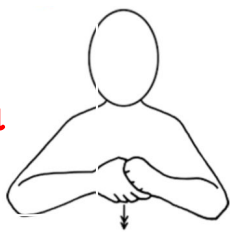


Sign of the Week
