Maths

- We will continue work on our times tables - can we all learn our 3 times tables?
- We will be working on how to solve addition sums using column addition and then move onto column subtraction
- We all need to be able to solve sums at speed - can we do regular checks that everyone can add and subtract numbers together? For example 3+4=, 10-5=

- Discuss fire safety
 - What are our rights? Discuss our fortnightly values and how we can go for gold!
 - Children's Rights Week: 10th November
 - Would you have wanted to live in the past? Give reasons.

Science and Technology

- We will also be learning about different materials and how they are used:
- Investigate which materials are waterproof
 - Identify objects that are made from natural, human made and recyclable materials.
 - Explore the Big Question: What material would you use to make an umbrella?

Expressive Arts

- Digital media
- Basic line drawing and adding some tonal elements, e.g. light and dark

Humanities

- In 1666, a tiny spark in London grew into a fire so big it changed the city forever! We will be finding out about the Great Fire of London!
- Children will explore big questions like 'Where did the world come from?' They will learn how Christians and Muslims believe God created the world, and think about their own ideas too.

Home learning

- Weekly reading, Spelling and Times Table practice - 2's 5's and 10's
- Try making simple bread rolls together, just like in Thomas Farriner's bakery where the fire began.
- Build a house from cardboard or Lego and see how close houses were in 1666.
- Do some fire art – draw or paint flames and buildings
- Sort materials – look at wood, brick, metal, and talk about which burn easily
- find Pudding Lane and the River Thames on a simple map of London.
- Sing "London's Burning"
