



















<p>Samuel Pepys</p> <p>Can you write a daily diary just like Samuel Pepys? Write about the fire as he did, research how it started and where and how they stopped the fire. Here are the days of the week that you will need to help. Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.</p> <p></p>	<p>Junk Modelling</p> <p>Use any recycling materials and get your craft on by making your own Pudding Lane house! Build it tall or small, thin or wide – you could even use coloured paper to make the fire!
