



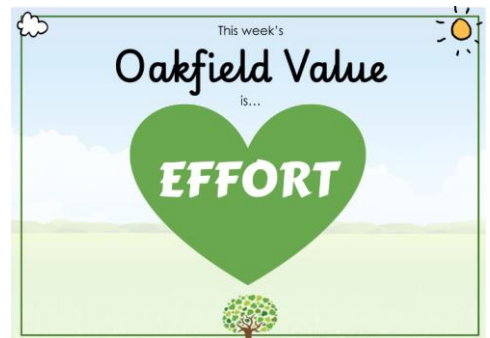
# School Christmas Fayre

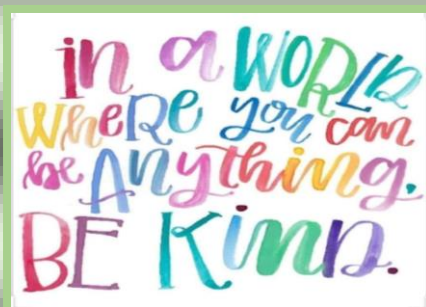
